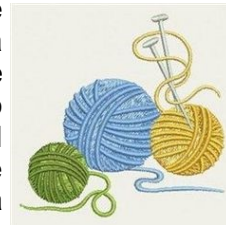

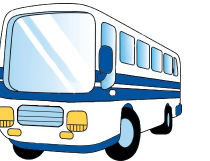
MINISTRY NOTES
