The annual meeting will be held between worship services at **9:15 a.m.** Sunday, February 3.

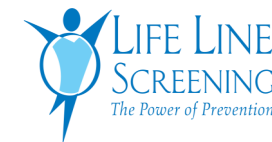

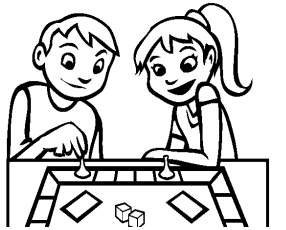

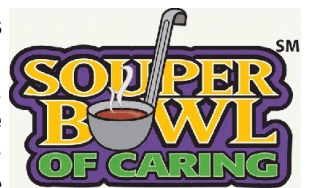
